They will be speaking on transportation issues and land use issues. They will be available to answer your questions. We need you to attend and show our politicians that we are paying attention.

The JMCA Board is the community's voice with our local politicians. I can't express how valuable it is to have a citizens association to represent our neighborhood's priorities to our politicians. We bring focus and attention to areas that are important to the neighborhood. Instead of one citizen speaking, we speak for over 550 households! Politicians listen and things get done. Unfortunately, this March at least four Board seats will be vacated due largely to personal circumstances. We need your help. We need dedicated individuals who are willing to give 6 to 10 hours a month to help Jefferson Manor. Now is the time to volunteer your time. If we don't get enough dedicated individuals to participate as JMCA Board members and Committee members, we will have to re-examine what is possible for us to achieve in 2007. I encourage you to contact anyone on the Board to see how you can help today.

JMCA has accomplished a lot this year. We worked with the community to develop a neighborhood position on the proposed redevelopment of Huntington Station. We developed a vision for pedestrian access to the metro on North Kings Highway and worked with County staff to get a traffic study of the neighborhood to determine the feasibility of adding traffic calming measures to Edgehill Drive and Fort Drive. The JMCA worked with Del. Englin and Supervisor Kauffman to



obtain funding for the road improvement project on Fort Drive. We recruited block captains for neighborhood watch, held numerous social events, launched and continually update the website, published six newsletters, and worked tirelessly on behalf of the neighborhood. I hope you attended our most recent event: the Halloween Parade & Costume Contest. We had a great turn out and wide array of

costumes (see page 4).

Please join us December 2<sup>nd</sup> at Janet's Java from 5 to 9 PM for our Annual Holiday Party (see page 3). Happy Holidays! 



#### **Roads Update**

As everyone is probably aware, the replacement of the gas lines on Fort Drive is underway. This is one of many steps in the renovation process that will eventually produce a smooth Fort Drive, new sidewalks, and new water and gas lines. The full construction and repaving is slated to begin in the Spring, but this timetable may have to be amended if Fairfax County and the Virginia Department of Transportation are not able to bid out the project in the coming weeks. The bidding process cannot begin until all Fort Drive residents have responded to the acquisition or easement agreements from Fairfax County. To date, Fairfax County has not received responses from numerous Fort Drive residents. If you are a Fort Drive resident that has not yet responded to an acquisition or easement notice from Fairfax County, please send in your paperwork! If you recently purchased a home on Fort Drive and are unaware if your acquisition or easement is still pending, please contact Fairfax County at 703-324-1100.


